Year 6 Secondary School Transition Support

Friday saw children allocated their secondary school places. Whilst many of the children and parents will be happy with their places, we know some of you will be worried or upset if your child was allocated a place in school you didn't choose. If this is the case, we would advise parents to lodge an appeal with the school / admissions authority as soon as possible. Once you have logged that you wish to appeal, if you would like a supporting letter from us, please email your child's class teacher at year6@millhouse.essex.sch.uk and they will write one for you. Please note, that this will take a few days to complete so make sure you ask the teacher in enough time to be able to use it in any appeal that may be organised. We are unable to contact any secondary school or the local authority directly.

To support the children's transition into secondary school, we will be delivering a range of sessions, activities and approaches that will hopefully help the children feel confident about moving on. We will also touch upon this as part of the parent workshop on 19th March.
