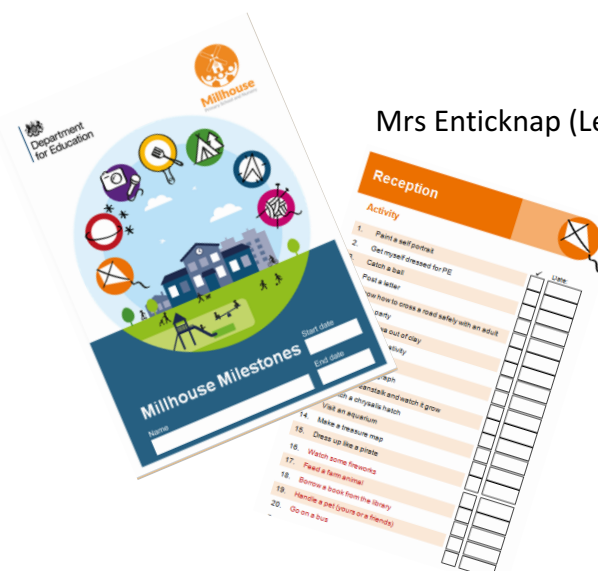

If they would like to bring in a photo, artefact or piece of writing for any milestones they complete, we will add them to our Millhouse Milestones board. The children will then talk about their experiences in class and add their ticks to their passport.

When children have completed all of the activities for their year group, there will be an award ceremony, where their achievement will be celebrated. We aim to ensure our children have all of the experiences within the passport by the time they leave our school in Year 6.
