How to keep your brain healthy: your 5 a day homework tasks

Every day:

- 5 minutes spelling
- 5 minutes counting in 2's, 5's 10's, forwards and backwards and counting on and back in ones from any number from 0-100
- 5 minutes (or more) reading
- 5 minutes discussing what you've read
- 5 minutes chat about what you have learnt that day

Choose 3 items from the sweets below to be handed in by Monday 20th May or as soon as you have finished it. Well-presented homework will be displayed around our school and children who have completed 3 items will receive a special homework certificate!

Make a 3D story map of the setting for the Three Little Pigs or Little Red Riding Hood.

Go on a material hunt around your home. Which things are made from glass, wood, brick, metal or plastic?

Find a book with wolves in (fact or fiction) and bring it in to show the class.

Take a walk in the woods and make up your own wolf story. It would be lovely if you wrote it.

Collect some leaves and identify what tree they come from.

Find some sticks and order them by length – use the words, shorter, shortest, longer, longest to compare.

- The wolves at Paradise Wildlife Park or Colchester Zoo.
- Nature walks and experiences through the Essex Wildlife Trust.
- The Library and ask about wolf books and stories.
