Bikes & Scooters

If children ride a bike or scooter to or from school, they must do so safely and sensibly.

Children must get off the bike or scooter before coming in the school gate and push it across the playgrounds to the nearest bike shelter. Riding on the playground is not allowed anymore as we have had a number of near misses where children or adults have almost been hurt. This is for both before and after school.

After School Playing

Whilst it is lovely to see the children playing on our grounds after school, it is important to remember that parents are responsible for their children after school. If parents are on site, they must always supervise their child and if a child takes themselves home, the parent is still responsible for making sure they leave the school site at the right time.

Unfortunately, we have had children not playing sensibly or safely and children writing graffiti on the sheds whilst their parents are on the school grounds. This isn't acceptable behaviour and goes against our 3 Bs. Thank you.
